Someone who is interested in Anthroposophy and ongoing self-development and has knowledge of Steiner Education will also be highly regarded.

Ideally, the person will have prior experience in a Steiner early childhood environment and/or early childhood training in Steiner Education.

The co-educator has an integral role to play in the Kindergarten program and is a valued team member. Not only is the co-educator a support for the teacher but, due to the nature of the work, they are also a role model for the children.
